Douglas Bostock – Conductor Recordings of British Music

This is a list of CD recordings of British music conducted by Douglas Bostock, mainly since 1997. Orchestrations of other composers' music are listed under both composers but counted only once. The number of compositions (at the time of compilation) is 169, of which 82 are world premiere recordings.

George Frederic Handel is included in the list based on the fact that he settled in Great Britain, spent most of his life there and became a naturalized citizen. Although Percy Grainger was born in the British overseas territory of Australia (formerly, the Empire), he finds his place in this discography from having lived in the UK and in consideration of his extensive and pioneering work in the field of British folk song,

Douglas Bostock wishes to thank Lewis Foreman for his great support regarding repertoire and for providing liner notes for many of the CD booklets. Furthermore, without the wonderful cooperation of the orchestras, soloists, recording teams, and record labels this discography of British music would not have been possible.
